# A Message from Pastor Mary

Greetings in the Name of Christ!

I just got home from Virginia Annual Conference and a couple days of the beach. We will have reports from General Conference and Annual Conference, as well as an extensive Financial Report at a congregational meeting after church on July 14.

When I finally got home, it was all hands-on deck to do laundry, go shopping, and look through the mail. And then there was our poor peace plant! It was dropping from not enough water. The leaves and blooms were bowed down and looked quite dead, even though we had put into the pot, a globe of water.

John watered the plant, and we waited. Sure enough, the blooms started to straighten out and stand tall. Then the leaves began to perk up. This is why I love peace plants! They tell the story of forgiveness and grace.

When we have sinned and fallen short of the Glory of God, we begin to fall as well. We may not notice, but God does. We sort of droop away from God. If we continue, we look like my "dead" plant. But if we confess our sin and rehydrate with the forgiveness and grace of God, we are filled to overflowing with life giving water that will help us to walk straight and tall with God. And people will notice!

Jeremiah 2:13 states: "My people have committed two sins; They have forsaken me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water."

So often we commit these same sins. We are thirsty for living water from God yet we look for something to quench our thirsty souls from other sources that cannot help. We stay thirsty. We droop. We die and life becomes hard, sad, confused, and complicated. Those other cisterns may be our family, job, books, food, medicine, alcohol, shopping, or any other thing we think makes us fulfilled...anything we use to replace God in our life.




#### **Vacation Bible School**


